

2010-2011 ROAD INVESTMENTS

HIGHLIGHTS

- Significant improvement of the state of the road network: between 2006 and 2009, the proportion of roads in good condition increased by 6%; for structures, this proportion is 8%.
- In 2010-2011, close to \$3.5 billion will be invested in road infrastructures. With the contribution of partners, these investments will represent close to \$4.2 billion.
- Asset maintenance and network improvement represent \$2.9 billion of the 2010-2011 envelope.
- Close to \$1.2 billion will be invested in the preservation of structures.
- \$1.5 billion of these investments are earmarked for activities that will contribute to improving road safety.
- 58% of the investments are allocated to the regions.
- 56,304 jobs will be created or maintained.
- 1,714 worksites across the province.
- Interventions on 857 structures, including 261 on the municipal network.
- 1,700 kilometres of road will be renovated.
- By 2014, close to \$21 billion will have been invested since 2007 to update the road network, in addition to the contributions of partners (\$2.7 billion).
